Terms and conditions

Approval to use the Medicare Australia Small Business Superannuation Clearing House (the Clearing House) trademark is subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. I agree that:

- if our organisation fails to comply with these terms and conditions, Medicare Australia reserves the right to revoke, without notice, any approval given to our organisation to use the Clearing House trademark

- in the event that the Clearing House trademark is featured on material and/or on a website that is deemed by Medicare Australia to contain offensive, discriminatory, unlawful or otherwise inappropriate material, Medicare Australia reserves the right to revoke, without notice, any approval given to our organisation to use the Clearing House trademark
- Medicare Australia reserves the right to modify the Clearing House trademark at any time, without notice
- Medicare Australia is not responsible for any costs or losses incurred by our organisation in using the Clearing House trademark
