



Terms and conditions of approval of (proprietor)
in respect of (hospital)

Subsection 94(2), National Health Act 1953

I,,
Manager, Program Delivery Section, Pharmaceutical Benefits Branch of Medicare Australia and of the
delegate of the Chief Executive Officer, on behalf of the Minister for Health and Ageing, hereby
determine for the purposes of subsection 94(2) of the *National Health Act 1953* that the following
terms and conditions are those to which the approval of the
(proprietor) is subject in respect of making supplies to eligible patients receiving treatment at the
above hospital. It is understood that the hospital is under the control of the above mentioned
governing body.

1. Claims shall only be lodged by the governing body upon the Australian Government in respect of the supply of pharmaceutical benefits to persons.
 - who are receiving treatment as admitted patients upon discharge or as non-admitted patients of the hospital which is under the control of the governing body or proprietor; or
 - who received treatment as admitted patients upon discharge or as non-admitted patients of another public hospital that is participating in the Variation to the Australian Health Care Agreement allowing for Pharmaceutical reforms;
 provided that the hospital may supply drugs under the Chemotherapy Pharmaceuticals Access Program to day admitted patients.
2. Claims shall not be lodged by the hospital upon the Australian Government in respect of the supply of pharmaceutical benefits to patients who are not eligible persons within the meaning of the *Health Insurance Act 1973*.
3. The hospital is required to:
 - maintain medication records that are sufficient to allow an independent audit to ascertain that pharmaceutical benefits have been supplied only in accordance with paragraph 1 above; and
 - allow the inspection and taking of copies of those records by officers of Medicare Australia at mutually arranged times, should Medicare Australia consider it necessary.
4. The hospital will comply with the determinations made by the Minister under sections 85 and 85A of the *National Health Act 1953* in respect of the form or brand of drugs and medicinal preparations, the class of persons by which they may be prescribed, the maximum quantities that may be supplied on any one occasion, the maximum number of occasions on which supplies may be directed to be repeated, and the manner of administration that may be directed.
5. The hospital will comply with:
 - the requirements set out in the *Schedule of Pharmaceutical Benefits* published from time to time by the Department of Health and Ageing; and
 - such further terms and conditions as are set by the Minister for Health and Ageing or a person exercising that power on the Minister's behalf.
